In 2014, the Institut Choiseul led by Dr. Pascal Lorot started publishing the Under 40 **Choiseul 100 Africa** ranking of African economic leaders. This unique ranking sheds light on the 200 most successful of their generation, and the part they play in developing the economic influence of ever-changing Africa.

After a first meeting in Paris in June 2015, a second one in November 2015 in Marrakech and a third in June 2016 in Paris, the Institut Choiseul will gather the Choiseul 100 Africa laureates as well as various European leaders **for the fourth time in Cairo on January 22 & 23**. This event will be the perfect occasion for African leaders and economic and political key players to meet and exchange.

These summits are organised on a regular basis, both in Europe and Africa. They allow both continents to create new bonds, promote a constructive and independent mindset to ensure mutual growth. Nearly a hundred of this generation's most emblematic African leaders coming from some 35 countries will be in Cairo on January 22 & 23. They will meet among others H.E Eng. Ibrahim Mahlab, **Former Prime Minister of the Arab Republic of Egypt**, Advisor to the President of the Arab Republic of Egypt, in charge of National Projects, **the Egyptian Minister of Investment**, H.E. Dalia Korshid, **the Egyptian Minister of Military Production**, General Mohamed El Assar and key leading Egyptian investors and businessmen.
