Growing business leaders, successful entrepreneurs, investors, etc., they embody the dynamism and renewal of a whole continent and carry the hopes of an entire generation.


#### MAIN RESULTS

Out of the 54 African countries, 42 are represented in the study.

#### Leading countries by region


Nigeria: 17 laureates Morocco: 16 laureates Kenya: 15 laureates South Africa: 15 laureates Cameroon: 8 laureates
